



United Twirl England Conduct and Ethics Policy

Athletes, Coaches, Judges, Technical / Executive Members, Parents, Guardians and / or Club Representatives must conduct themselves in a professional, courteous and orderly manner at all times. They must demonstrate positive sportsperson conduct and must not behave in a way that would bring the sport of baton twirling and the United Twirl England association into disrepute.

If any Athletes, Coaches, Judges, Technical / Executive Members, Parents, Guardians and / or Club Representative post on social media, then it should be a positive reflection of the sport of baton twirling. There should be no inappropriate, abusive or discriminatory comments regarding any athlete, performance, judge, club or other person.

All Athletes, Coaches, Judges, Technical / Executive Members, Parents, Guardians and / or Club Representatives should act in an ethical manner, adhering to the moral principles that govern an individual or group's positive behaviour. They should distinguish between acceptable (right) and unacceptable (wrong) and behave accordingly in respect of their responsibilities and decision making.

Any complaints made regarding Athletes, Coaches, Judges, Technical / Executive Members, Parents, Guardians and / or Club Representative's conduct, any form of abuse (including discriminatory) or unethical behaviour may result in an investigation and subsequent sanctions being imposed.
