



United Twirl England Privacy Policy

Introduction

United Twirl England (UTE, we, our, us) is committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and safeguard your information when you visit our website (www.unitedtwirlengland.org.uk) use our services, or interact with us in any other way.

This policy will be reviewed annually by the Board.

Note: The term 'athlete' describes any person partaking in the sport of baton twirling. References to 'parents' should be read as parents and carers inclusively. 'Technical Members' describes coaches, judges, club directors registered with UTE.

Information We Collect

We **may** collect and process the following data about you - dependant on your position within UTE:

- **Personal Identification Information:** Name, email address, phone number, etc.

How We Collect Information

We collect information in the following ways:

- directly from you when you/your club provide it to us

Use of Your Information

We use the information we collect for various purposes, including:

- to provide, operate, and maintain our services
- to provide Membership of the association
- to communicate with you/your club

Sharing Your Information

We will only share your information with third parties in the following situations:

- to comply with legal obligations
- to protect and defend our rights and property
- with your consent.

Data Retention

We will retain your personal information only for as long as is necessary for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy, and to the extent necessary to comply with our legal obligations, resolve disputes, and enforce our policies.



Security of Your Information

We use administrative, technical, and physical security measures to help protect your personal information. However, no method of transmission over the internet, or method of electronic storage, is 100% secure.

Your Data Protection Rights

You may have the following rights regarding your personal data:

- the right to access – you have the right to request copies of your personal data
- the right to rectification – you have the right to request that we correct any information you believe is inaccurate
- the right to erasure – you have the right to request that we erase your personal data, under certain conditions
